Quran (cont'd)

- ▶ Except | those who | they have believed | and they have done | good | and they have exhorted one another | in truth | and they have exhorted one another | in patience
- ▶ Except those who believe and do good works, and exhort one another to *accept* truth, and exhort one another to be steadfast.

▶ History of Ahmadiyya

◦ 1889

- January 12: Hd. Mirza Ghulam Ahmad of Qadian (AS) announced the acceptance of allegiance (bai`a)
- March 23: Hd. Mirza Ghulam Ahmad (AS) accepted the allegiance for the first time at the house of Hd. Sufi Ahmad Jan, signifying the foundation of Jamaat Ahmadiyya (Ahmadiyya Community). The first person who took the allegiance was Hd. Hakeem Maulvi Nuruddin (RA)

◦ 1890 ... 1908

- Hd. Mirza Ghulam Ahmad announce his Messiahship as The Promised Messiah – Masih Mau`ood (AS) ...
