- ▶ Those | on | guidance | from | their Lord | and those | they | people who prosper
- ▶ *It is* they who follow the guidance of their Lord and *it is* they who shall prosper.

Quran (cont'd)

◀ إِنَّ الَّذِينَ كَفَرُوا سَوَاءٌ عَلَيْهِمْ ءَأَنذَرْتَهُمْ أَمْ لَمْ

تُنذِرْهُمْ لَا يُؤْمِنُونَ

- ▶ Indeed | those who | (they) have disbelieved | equal | to them | whether you warn them | or | not | you warn them | not | they believe
- ▶ Those who have disbelieved – *it being* equal to them whether thou hast warned them or thou hast warned them not – they will not believe.
