Quran – Lafz Jalalah

- ▶ **لَامُ الْجَلَالَةِ** or **لَفْظُ الْجَلَالَةِ** is ل in the word **الله** .
- ▶ Two rules in reading the word:
 1. **مُفَخَّمٌ** : thickened
preceded by fathah (َ) or dammah (ُ)
 2. **مُرَفَّقٌ** : lightened
preceded by kasrah (ِ)

Quran – Lafz Jalalah (cont'd)

▶ Examples:

1. مُفَخَّمٌ

عَاهَدَ عَلَيْهِ اللهُ – رُسُلُ اللهِ – قَالُوا اللَّهُمَّ

2. مُرَفَّقٌ

يَرْفَعِ اللهُ – وَبِاللهِ – بِسْمِ اللهِ

Others have to be read مُرَفَّقٌ

رُسُلَنَا – وَيُصَلِّي – أَرْسَلَهُ – الَّذِي

- ▶ *O you who are* the Fountain of Allah's munificence and gratitude,
People rush towards you, thirstily.

Reading (cont'd)

2. يَا بَحْرَ فَضْلِ الْمُنْعِمِ الْمَنَّانِ
تَهَوَّى إِلَيْكَ الزُّمَرُ بِالْكَيْزَانِ

- ▶ O *you who are* the Ocean of the Bestower of Favors, the Beneficence
Hordes of *thirsty* people hurry towards you holding their bowls.

Reading (cont'd)

3. يَا شَمْسَ مُلْكِ الْحُسْنِ وَالْإِحْسَانِ
نَوَّرْتَ وَجْهَ الْبَرِّ وَالْعُمْرَانَ

- ▶ O *you who are* the Sun of the Kingdom of Beauty and Grace
You have illuminated the deserts as well as the cities.

Reading (cont'd)

.4 قَوْمٌ سَأَوْكَ وَأُمَّةٌ قَدْ أُخْبِرَتْ
مِنْ ذَلِكَ الْبَدْرِ الَّذِي أَصْبَانِي

- ▶ A *group of* people saw you, while others simply heard about you

The *enchantingly beautiful* Full Moon which has cast a spell over me.

Reading (cont'd)

يَكُونُ مَنْ ذَكَرِ الْجَمَالَ صَبَابَةً
وَتَأَلَّمْنَا مِنْ لَوْعَةِ الْهَجْرَانِ

- ▶ Inspired by *your* love *O Holy Prophet*, people tearfully recall your beauty
And their aching hearts are afire, due to being distant from you.
