- ▶ They are deceiving | Allah | and (those) who | have believed | and none | they deceive | but | themselves | and not | they perceive
- ▶ They would deceive Allah and those who believed, and they deceive none but themselves; only they perceive *it* not.

▶ فِي قُلُوبِهِمْ مَرَضٌ فَزَادَهُمُ اللَّهُ مَرَضًا وَلَهُمْ عَذَابٌ أَلِيمٌ

بِمَا كَانُوا يَكْذِبُونَ

- ▶ In | their hearts | a disease | then has increased on them | Allah | a disease | and for them | a punishment | grievous | for | they have been | lying
- ▶ In their hearts was a disease, and Allah has increased their disease to them; and for them is a grievous punishment because they lied.

- ▶ Al-Mu'min (The Bestower of Security)

أَلْمُؤْمِنُ ❖

- ▶ Surah Al-Hashr (59) 24
 - (24) He is Allah, and there is no God beside Him, the Sovereign, the Holy One, the Source of Peace, **the Bestower of Security**, the Protector, the Mighty, the Subduer, the Exalted. Holy is Allah *far* above that which they associate *with Him*.
