Quran (cont'd)

- ▶ Allah will punish their mockery and will let them continue in their transgression, wandering blindly.
- ▶ These are they who have taken error *in exchange* for guidance; but their traffic has brought them no gain, nor are they rightly guided.

◦ Quranic verses

إِنَّ الدِّينَ عِنْدَ اللَّهِ الْإِسْلَامُ قَدْ

Surely, the *true* religion with Allah is Islam (complete submission). (Ali `Imran (3) 20)

وَمَنْ يَبْتَغِ غَيْرَ الْإِسْلَامِ دِينًا فَلَنْ يُقْبَلَ مِنْهُ ج

And whoso seeks a religion other than Islam, it shall not be accepted from him, (Ali `Imran (3) 86)

Reading (cont'd)

الْيَوْمَ أَكْمَلْتُ لَكُمْ دِينَكُمْ وَأَتْمَمْتُ عَلَيْكُمْ نِعْمَتِي
وَرَضِيتُ لَكُمُ الْإِسْلَامَ دِينًا

This day have I perfected your religion for you and completed My favour upon you and have chosen for you Islam as religion. (Al-Maidah (5) 4)

◦ بُنِيَ الْإِسْلَامُ عَلَى خَمْسٍ شَهَدَةِ أَنْ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَأَنَّ مُحَمَّدًا رَسُولُ اللَّهِ
وَإِقَامِ الصَّلَاةِ وَإِيتَاءِ الزَّكَاةِ وَالْحُجِّ وَصَوْمِ رَمَضَانَ

Islam is founded by five (pillars): bearing witness that there is no god but Allah and that Muhammad is the Messenger of Allah, observing Salat, paying Zakat, Hajj (pilgrimage) and Fasting in the month of Ramadan.

Etiquettes – Road/Pathways

 - ▶ If you are going up a slope, recite *Allahu Akbar*, while going down recite *Subhanallah*.
 - ▶ Refrain from walking barefoot.
 - ▶ Do not drag your feet.
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
