- ▶ Those | who | bought | error/astay | for guidance | then not | (would) earn | their trade | and not | they (would) be | people who are guided

Quran (cont'd)

- ▶ Allah will punish their mockery and will let them continue in their transgression, wandering blindly.
- ▶ These are they who have taken error *in exchange* for guidance; but their traffic has brought them no gain, nor are they rightly guided.

إِنَّ اللَّهَ هُوَ الرَّزَّاقُ ذُو الْقُوَّةِ الْمَتِينُ ﴿٥٩﴾

- Surely, it is Allah *Himself* Who is **the Great Sustainer**, the Powerful, the Strong.

إِنَّ الدِّينَ عِنْدَ اللَّهِ الْإِسْلَامُ قَدْ

Surely, the *true* religion with Allah is Islam (complete submission). (Ali `Imran (3) 20)

And whoso seeks a religion other than Islam, it shall not be accepted from him, (Ali `Imran (3) 86)

Islam is founded by five (pillars): bearing witness that there is no god but Allah and that Muhammad is the Messenger of Allah, observing Salat, paying Zakat, Hajj (pilgrimage) and Fasting in the month of Ramadan.
