Salat – Salat Janazah

- ▶ **Funeral Prayer (Salat Janazah) – 4 Takbirat**
 - In congregation led by an Imam.
 - The wrapped body is laid in front of the Imam for the Prayer. No ruku` and no sajdah.
 - The rows behind the Imam should be in odd numbers.
- ▶ **First Takbir: Thana, Ta'awwuz, Surah Al-Fatihah.**
- ▶ **Second Takbir: Durood Shareef**
- ▶ **Third Takbir: Funeral Prayer**
- ▶ **Fourth Takbir**
- ▶ **Salam**

► Funeral Prayer (after 3rd Takbir)

أَللَّهُمَّ اغْفِرْ لِحَيِّنَا وَمَيِّتِنَا وَشَاهِدِنَا وَغَائِبِنَا وَصَغِيرِنَا

وَكَبِيرِنَا وَذَكَرِنَا وَأَنْثَانَا

أَللَّهُمَّ مَنْ أَحْيَيْتَهُ مِنَّا فَأَحْيِهِ عَلَى الْإِسْلَامِ وَمَنْ تَوَفَّيْتَهُ مِنَّا

فَتَوَفَّهُ عَلَى الْإِيمَانِ

أَللَّهُمَّ لَا تَحْرِمْنَا أَجْرَهُ (أَجْرَهَا) وَلَا تَفْتِنَّا بَعْدَهُ (بَعْدَهَا)

Memorization

- ▶ **Funeral Prayer (after 3rd Takbir) – Translation**
 - O Allah! Forgive our living ones and our deceased ones; and those of us who are present and our absent ones; and our young ones and our old ones; and our males and our females.
 - O Allah! Those of us whom You grant life, keep them firm on Islam; and those of us whom You cause to die, cause them to die in the faith.
 - Deprive us not, O Allah, of the benefits relating to **him (her)** (the deceased) and subject us not trial after **him (her)**.

Two (women) witnesses شَهِدَتَانِ

Many (women) witnesses شَهِدَاتُ

- Name: Hadhrat Mirza Nasir Ahmad
- Son of Hd. Muslih Mau`ood (RA)
- Name of Mother: Hd. Mahmooda Begum
- Grandson of Hd. Masih Mau`ood (AS) and of Hd. Khalifa Rasheeduddin (RA)
- Born: November 16, 1909 in Qadian
- At the age of 13, memorize the Holy Quran by heart (Hafiz)

▶ **Hd. Khalifatul Masih IV (RH)**

- Name: Hadhrat Mirza Tahir Ahmad
- Son of Hd. Muslih Mau`ood (RA)
- Name of Mother: Hd. Maryam Syeda
- Grandson of Hd. Masih Mau`ood (AS) and of Hd. Syed Abdus Sattar Shah (RA)
- Obtained his high school education in 1944 Talimul Islam High School, Qadian and then his higher secondary education from Government College Lahore.

Reading (cont'd)

▶ History of Ahmadiyya

◦ 1908

- May 26–27: Demise of Hd. Mirza Ghulam Ahmad of Qadian (AS). Hd. Hakeem Nuruddin (RA) elected as Khalifatul Masih I.
- May 30: Hd. Khalifatul Masih I (RA) appointed Hd. Sahibzada Mirza Bashiruddin Mahmood Ahmad (RA) to chair the first meeting of Sadr Anjuman Ahmadiyya. Hd. Khalifatul Masih I (RA) set up Baitul Mal (Treasury).
