# Salat – Salat Janazah

- ▶ **Funeral Prayer (Salat Janazah) – 4 Takbirat**
  - In congregation led by an Imam.
  - The wrapped body is laid in front of the Imam for the Prayer. No ruku` and no sajdah.
  - The rows behind the Imam should be in odd numbers.
- ▶ **First Takbir: Thana, Ta'awwuz, Surah Al-Fatihah.**
- ▶ **Second Takbir: Durood Shareef**
- ▶ **Third Takbir: Funeral Prayer**
- ▶ **Fourth Takbir**
- ▶ **Salam**

## ► Funeral Prayer (after 3<sup>rd</sup> Takbir)

أَللَّهُمَّ اغْفِرْ لِحَيِّنَا وَمَيِّتِنَا وَشَاهِدِنَا وَغَائِبِنَا وَصَغِيرِنَا

وَكَبِيرِنَا وَذَكَرِنَا وَأَنْثَانَا

أَللَّهُمَّ مَنْ أَحْيَيْتَهُ مِنَّا فَأَحْيِهِ عَلَى الْإِسْلَامِ وَمَنْ تَوَفَّيْتَهُ مِنَّا

فَتَوَفَّهُ عَلَى الْإِيمَانِ

أَللَّهُمَّ لَا تَحْرِمْنَا أَجْرَهُ (أَجْرَهَا) وَلَا تَفْتِنَّا بَعْدَهُ (بَعْدَهَا)

# Memorization

  - O Allah! Forgive our living ones and our deceased ones; and those of us who are present and our absent ones; and our young ones and our old ones; and our males and our females.
  - O Allah! Those of us whom You grant life, keep them firm on Islam; and those of us whom You cause to die, cause them to die in the faith.
  - Deprive us not, O Allah, of the benefits relating to **him (her)** (the deceased) and subject us not trial after **him (her)**.

- ▶ **Important Rules (in Salat)**
  - **Fara'id:** things that are obligated in Salat
  - **Wajibat:** things that are required in Salat
  - **Sunnat:** things that are desirable in Salat
  - **Mustahabat:** things that beautify Salat
  - **Makruhat:** things that are undesirable in Salat
  - **Mubtilat:** things that break Salat
- ▶ **Sajdah Sahvi:** sajdah because of forgetfulness


## ▶ **Salat Categories**

- **Salat Fard** (Obligatory Prayer): Five Daily Prayers
- **Salat Wajib** (Required Prayer): Vitr, Eid-ul Fitr, Eid-ul Adhiya, Eclipses
- **Salat Sunnah** (Traditional Prayer): Additional Prayers before and/or after Salat Fard
- **Salat Nafilah** (Optional Prayer): Tahajjud, Ishraq, Tahiyatul Wudu, Tahiyatul Masjid, Istikharah, Hajat

# The Promised Messiah Day (Masih Mau'ood Day)

- ▶ The foundation of Jamaat Ahmadiyya (Ahmadiyya Muslim Community), March 23, 1889
  - ▶ Ordained by God Almighty.
  - ▶ In Ludhiana at the house of Hd. Sufi Ahmad Jaan (RA)
  - ▶ 40 men initiated at the hand of Hd. Mirza Ghulam Ahmad, individually.
  - ▶ Hd. Maulana Hakeem Nuruddin (RA) was the first.
