- ▶ **In** *the* name *of* Allah, The Gracious, The Merciful.

▶ Al-Fil 2

أَلَمْ تَرَ كَيْفَ فَعَلَ رَبُّكَ بِأَصْحَابِ الْفِيلِ ﴿٢﴾

◀ أَلَمْ | تَرَ | كَيْفَ | فَعَلَ | رَبُّكَ | بِأَصْحَابِ | الْفِيلِ

- ▶ ? not | you see | how | has done | your Lord | with the people | of the Elephant
- ▶ Hast thou not seen how thy Lord dealt with the People of the Elephant?

Quran (cont'd)

▶ Al-Fil 3

أَلَمْ يَجْعَلْ كَيْدَهُمْ فِي تَضْلِيلٍ ﴿٣﴾

◀ أَلَمْ | يَجْعَلُ | كَيْدَهُمْ | فِي | تَضْلِيلٍ

- ▶ ? not | He makes | their machination | in | mislead
- ▶ Did He not cause their plan to miscarry?

Quran (cont'd)

▶ Al-Fil 4

وَأَرْسَلَ عَلَيْهِمْ طَيْرًا أَبَابِيلَ ﴿٤﴾

◀ وَأَرْسَلَ | عَلَيْهِمْ | طَيْرًا | أَبَابِيلَ

- ▶ And He sent | against them | birds | swarms
- ▶ And He sent against them swarms of birds,

Quran (cont'd)

▶ Al-Fil 5

تَرْمِيهِمْ بِحِجَارَةٍ مِّنْ سِجِّيلٍ ﴿٥﴾

◀ تَرْمِيهِمْ | بِحِجَارَةٍ | مِنْ | سِجِّيلٍ

- ▶ (they) strike them | with stones | of | clay
- ▶ Which ate their carrion, striking them against stones of clay.

Quran (cont'd)

▶ Al-Fil 6

فَجَعَلَهُمْ كَعَصْفٍ مَّأْكُولٍ ﴿٦﴾

◀ فَجَعَلَهُمْ | كَعَصْفٍ | مَّأْكُولٍ

- ▶ Then | He made them | like broken straw | eaten up
- ▶ And *thus* made them like broken straw, eaten up.

Quran (Arabic)

- ▶ Perfect Tense (فِعْلٌ مَّاضٍ) - *has done*

فَعَلَتْ فَعَلْنَا فَعَلْنَ

they they she

فَعَلَ فَعَلَا فَعَلُوا

they they he

فَعَلْتِ فَعَلْتُمَا فَعَلْتُنَّ

you you thou

فَعَلْتُمْ فَعَلْتُمَا فَعَلْتُمْ

Quran (Arabic – cont'd)

- ▶ Passive Participle (إِسْمٌ مَّفْعُولٍ) – *a person or a thing, who is done* مَّفْعُولٌ

مَفْعُولٌ مَفْعُولَانِ مَفْعُولَةٌ مَفْعُولُونَ مَفْعُولَانِ مَفْعُولَاتٌ
many both one many both one

Quran (Arabic – cont'd)

▶ *to do* فَعَلَ – مَفْعُولٌ

One man, who is done

مَفْعُولٌ

Two men, who are done

مَفْعُولَانِ

Many men, who are done

مَفْعُولُونَ

One woman, who is done

مَفْعُولَةٌ

Two women, who are done

مَفْعُولَتَانِ

Many women, who are done

Quran (Arabic – cont'd)

- ▶ Perfect Tense (فِعْلٌ مَّاضٍ) – *has eaten* أَكَلَ

أَكَلَ أَكَلَا أَكَلُوا أَكَلْتُ أَكَلْتُمْ أَكَلْنَا أَكَلْنَا
they they she they they he

أَكَلْتِ أَكَلْتُمْ أَكَلْتُمْ أَكَلْتُمْ أَكَلْتُمْ أَكَلْتُمْ
you you thou you you thou

أَكَلْتُ أَكَلْنَا
we I

Quran (Arabic – cont'd)

- ▶ Passive Participle (إِسْمٌ مَّفْعُولٍ) - eaten
- One (male, thing) that was eaten مَا أُكُلُ
- Two (males, things) that were eaten مَا أُكُولَانِ
- Many (males, things) that were eaten مَا أُكُولُونَ
- One (female, thing) that was eaten مَا أُكُولَةٌ
- Two (females, things) that were eaten مَا أُكُولَتَانِ
- Many (females, things) that were eaten مَا أُكُولَاتٌ
