Quran – Lafz Jalalah

- ▶ **لَامُ الْجَلَالَةِ** or **لَفْظُ الْجَلَالَةِ** is ل in the word **الله** .
- ▶ Two rules in reading the word:
 1. **مُفَخَّمٌ** : thickened
preceded by fathah (َ) or dammah (ُ)
 2. **مُرَقَّقٌ** : lightened
preceded by kasrah (ِ)

Quran – Lafz Jalalah (cont'd)

▶ Examples:

1. مُفَخِّمٌ

عَاهَدَ عَلَيْهِ اللهُ – رُسُلُ اللهِ – قَالُوا اللَّهُمَّ

2. مُرَقِّقٌ

يَرْفَعِ اللهُ – وَبِاللهِ – بِسْمِ اللهِ

Others have to be read مُرَقِّقٌ

رُسُلَنَا – وَيُصَلِّ – أَرْسَلَهُ – الَّذِي
