- ▶ They are deceiving | Allah | and (those) who | have believed | and none | they deceive | but | themselves | and not | they perceive
- ▶ They would deceive Allah and those who believed, and they deceive none but themselves; only they perceive *it* not.

- ▶ In their hearts was a disease, and Allah has increased their disease to them; and for them is a grievous punishment because they lied.

▶ Islam


- Islam is an Arabic which literally peace and submission. So 'Islam' would mean the path of those who are submissive to Allah and who establish peace with Him and His creatures.
- Islam is perfect religion as stated in the Holy Quran:

الْيَوْمَ أَكْمَلْتُ لَكُمْ دِينَكُمْ

وَأَتَمَمْتُ عَلَيْكُمْ نِعْمَتِي وَرَضِيتُ


لَكُمْ الْإِسْلَامَ دِينًا

Reading (cont'd)

- *“This day have I perfected your religion for you and completed My favour upon you and have chosen for you Islam as religion”* (Al-Maidah (5) 4)
 - Islam is named by God.
 - Its teachings are simple and can be easily practiced by everyone.
 - It gives reason for each of its commandments and teachings, as its teachings have been perfected.

▶ Articles of Faith

- Allah Ta`ala
 - Allah creates everything.
 - Allah is One and Almighty. He has no partners.
 - He begets not, He has no children. Nor is He begotten, He has no parents.
 - He is Unique in His Being, He is Unique in His Attributes. No one is like unto Him.
 - He alone is worthy of worship.

- ▶ Shawwal 1, 1438 H = Ihsan 26, 1396 HS
- ▶ Eid Fitr Festival
- ▶ Fitrah (Fitrana)
- ▶ Salat Eid
 - Two (2) raka`at
 - Seven (7) additional takbirat in 1st raka`at
 - Five (5) additional takbirat in 2nd raka`at
