Quran (cont'd)

- ▶ And when it is said to them, “Believe as people have believed,” they say, “Shall we believe as the fools have believed?” Beware! *It is surely they who are* fools but they do not know.

Quran (cont'd)

- ▶ And when they meet those who believe, they say: “We believe;” but when they are alone with their ringleaders, they say: ‘We are certainly with you; we *are* only mocking.’

Quran (Arabic – cont'd)

- ▶ Perfect Tense (فِعْلٌ مَّاضٍ) – *to do*
