قَالُوا إِنَّا مَعَكُمْ إِنَّمَا نَحْنُ مُسْتَهْزِءُونَ

- ▶ And when | they meet | (those) who | have believed | they say | we have believed | and when | they are alone | toward | their satans | they say | indeed we | with you | indeed only | we | people who are mocking

Quran (cont'd)

- ▶ And when it is said to them, “Believe as people have believed,” they say, “Shall we believe as the fools have believed?” Beware! *It is surely they who are* fools but they do not know.
- ▶ And when they meet those who believe, they say: “We believe;” but when they are alone with their ringleaders, they say: ‘*We are certainly with you; we are* only mocking.’

Quran (Arabic – cont'd)

▶ God's revelations to The Promised Messiah (AS)

◦ Arabic:

أَلَيْسَ اللَّهُ بِكَافٍ عَبْدَهُ

Is Allah not sufficient for His servant?

◦ Persian:

تزلزل در ایوان کسری افتاد

An earthquake is in Kisra's court.

Reading (cont'd)

- **English:**

I shall give you a large party of Islam.

- **Urdu:**

میں تیری تبلیغ کو زمین کے کناروں تک پہنچاؤں گا

I will convey thy message to the corners of the world.

Reading (cont'd)

- Punjabi:

جے توں میرا ہور ہیں سب جگ تیرا ہو

If you become Mine, the whole world is yours.

Etiquettes – Road / Pathways
