Quran – Madd Far`ee

1. **أَلْمَدُّ الْفَرَعِيُّ** – extended (branch)

prolongation – ٦ – ٢

a. **أَلْمَدُّ الْإِلْزَامُ** :

أَلْسُكُونٌ – ٦ حَرَكَاتٍ

أَلْحُرُوفُ الْمُقَطَّعَةُ – ٦ حَرَكَاتٍ

أَلشَّدَّةُ – ٦ حَرَكَاتٍ

Quran – Madd Far`ee (cont'd)

Example:

مَلِكِ النَّاسِ – مَلِكِ النَّاسِ

مِثْلُ حَظِّ الْأُنثِيَيْنِ – مِثْلُ حَظِّ الْأُنثِيَيْنِ

بِهَا أَوْ دَيْنٍ – بِهَا أَوْ دَيْنٍ

حَم (حَامِيْم) – حَم

كَهَيْعَص (كَاف هَا يَا عَيْن صَاد) – كَهَيْعَص

قُلْ أَتَحَا جُونَنَا – قُلْ أَتَحَا جُونَنَا

Quran – Madd Far`ee (cont'd)

b. **أَمَدُ الْفَرْعِيِّ بِالْمُتَّصِلِ**: within one word

أَلشَّدَّةُ - آءٌ : ٦ حَرَكَاتٍ

أَلْهَمْزَةٌ - آءٌ : ٥ حَرَكَاتٍ

Example:

وَلَا الضَّالِّينَ - وَلَا الضَّالِّينَ

خَطِيئَتُهُ - خَطِيئَتُهُ

مِنْ سُوءٍ - مِنْ سُوءٍ

Quran (cont'd)

▶ Ali `Imran (3) 62

فَمَنْ حَاجَّكَ فِيهِ مِنْ بَعْدِ مَا جَاءَكَ مِنَ
الْعِلْمِ فَقُلْ تَعَالَوْا نَدْعُ أَبْنَاءَنَا
وَأَبْنَاءَكُمْ وَنِسَاءَنَا وَنِسَاءَكُمْ وَأَنْفُسَنَا
وَأَنْفُسَكُمْ ثُمَّ نَبْتَهِلْ فَنَجْعَلْ لَعْنَتَ

اللَّهِ عَلَى الْكٰذِبِيْنَ ﴿٦٢﴾

Quran (cont'd)

- ▶ Now whoso disputes with thee concerning him, after what has come to thee of knowledge, say *to him*, 'Come, let us call our sons and your sons, and our women and your women, and our people and your people; then let us pray fervently and invoke the curse of Allah on those who lie.'

Quran – Madd Far`ee (cont'd)

c. **أَمَدُ الْفَرْعِيِّ بِالْمُنْفَصِلِ**: between two words

◀ **أَاء** : ٢-٤ حَرَكَاتٍ

Example:

يَبْنِي أَدَمَ - يَبْنِي أَدَمَ
هَأَنْتُمْ هَأَوْلَاءِ - هَأَنْتُمْ هَأَوْلَاءِ
فِي رَبِّهِ أَنْ أَتَهُ اللَّهُ - فِي رَبِّهِ أَنْ أَتَهُ اللَّهُ

Quran (Arabic)

- ▶ Perfect Tense (فِعْلٌ مَّاضٍ) - *has done*

فَعَلَتْ فَعَلْنَا فَعَلْنَ

they they she

فَعَلَ فَعَلَا فَعَلُوا

they they he

فَعَلْتِ فَعَلْتُمَا فَعَلْتُنَّ

you you thou

فَعَلْتُمْ فَعَلْتُمَا فَعَلْتُمْ

you you thou

فَعَلْنَا

we

فَعَلْتُ

I

Quran (Arabic – cont'd)

- ▶ Active Participle (إِسْمٌ فَاعِلٍ) – *a person, who does; doer* فَاعِلٌ

فَاعِلَةٌ فَاعِلَتَانِ فَاعِلَاتٌ فَاعِلٌ فَاعِلَانِ فَاعِلُونَ

many both one many both one

▶ *to do* فَعَلَّ – فَاعِلٌ

One man, who does

فَاعِلٌ

Two men, who do

فَاعِلَانِ

Many men, who do

فَاعِلُونَ

One woman, who does

فَاعِلَةٌ

Two women, who do

فَاعِلَتَانِ

Many women, who do

Quran (Arabic)

- ▶ Perfect Tense (فِعْلٌ مَّاضٍ) - *has lied* كَذَبَ

كَذَبَ كَذَبًا كَذَبُوا كَذَبْتُ كَذَبْتَا كَذَبْنَ
they they she they they he

كَذَبْتَ كَذَبْتُمَا كَذَبْتُمْ كَذَبْتِ كَذَبْتِمَا كَذَبْتِنَّ
you you thou you you thou

كَذَبْتُ كَذَبْنَا
I we

Quran (Arabic – cont'd)

- ▶ Active Participle (إِسْمُ فَاعِلٍ) - *liar* كَاذِبٌ

One (man) liar

كَاذِبٌ

Two (men) liars

كَاذِبَانِ

Many (men) liars

كَاذِبُونَ

One (woman) liar

كَاذِبَةٌ

Two (women) liars

كَاذِبَتَانِ

Many (women) liars

كَاذِبَاتٌ

Hadith

لَيْسَ الْخَبْرُ كَالْمُعَايَنَةِ

Etiquettes – Travel/Journey

- ▶ While on a journey, shorten your Salat as per Islamic teachings: 4 raka'at to 2 raka'at (only).
- ▶ While traveling by train or bus, keep your head and arms inside the vehicle. While crossing a street or railroad tracks, look both ways and make sure your passage is safe.
- ▶ If you must stay with relatives (friends) during a journey, give them advanced notice of your travel plans. You should also inform your household of your return.
